Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by President Dianne Cooper at 9:30 am. All were welcomed.

Reports of Standing Committees

Raffle Tickets – LouEtta told the group that members have sold 30 more tickets since last month's meeting. So far, almost one half of our tickets have been sold for this year.

Program Coordinator – Tina told the group that she is planning a group sewing activity for after June's meeting. Members will work together to sew small items for the silent auction at the quilt show. Some of the items are a cell phone holder, a small mug rug, gift card holders, and small table runners. She said prizes will be awarded. She also passed out a sign-up sheet for those planning on attending that afternoon.

Community Service - Carolyn Nuss-Warren announced that 13 more Crumb Catchers were handed in to her since last month. This brings the total to 74 this year.

Fall Retreat – Marsha Hoisington announced that 15 members have signed up for the fall retreat. The sign-up is now open to non-Guild members.

Hostess – Diane Renander thanked Jody Meer and her co-hostesses for the great refreshments. The next meeting is June 17, 2017 at the West Way Christian Church. Head Hostess is Pat Kembel and co-hostesses are Cindy Scheinost, Jacci Irwin, Adei Hill, Janice Casey, and Wanda Mowry.

Block of the Month – There were a total of 16 blocks turned in for this month's block of the month. The winner of the blocks was Marsha Hoisington. The instructions were given for next month's block of the month. Anita Allen suggested the colors be a mix of dark, medium and light greens.

Librarian – Gayle Rojas highlighted several new books in the library. She also showed the Guild the flyers advertising the quilt show in July. She asked members to take several flyers with them after the meeting to place in public areas in their towns.

Membership – Diane Downer announced that 41 members and 2 guests (ReBanna Harsh and Cindy Rahmig) were in attendance. Diane also announced that dues are now being accepted for next year.

Quilt Show Chairman – Sharon Armstrong asked for volunteers to be contact persons for members of the public that would like to submit quilts for the quilt show. A volunteer is needed for the Bridgeport area. The deadline for quilt registrations is June 17. Quilt submissions are open Wednesday, July 12th from 5:00 to 7:00 PM, Thursday, July 13th from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Quilt Frames will then be set up. Friday, Saturday, and Sunday the show will be open from 12:00 to 5:00 PM. Shifts for volunteers will be 2 ½ hours. Volunteers are still needed – please contact Sharon. Lori Sanders said that more pot holders are being donated for the Silent Auction. She even has received the donation



of a hand pieced, hand quilted quilt for the auction. She still needs two more volunteers to help with the Silent Auction. A display of barn quilts is also being planned for the show. Marsha Hoisington will need easels to hold the display barn quilts.

Serendipity Quilt – The Serendipity quilt for 2018 was unveiled. Jody Meer did the quilting. All of the people working on the quilt gathered for a photo with the quilt.
